Question tags are short questions added to the end of statements **to confirm information or seek agreement.**

They help in making conversations more interactive. For instance, when you say;

- “It’s sunny, isn’t it?” you invite the listener to share their thoughts.

Using question tags correctly can enhance your conversational skills and clarity in communication, **making discussions more engaging and effective.**



# Understanding and Using Question Tags in English



Question tags are **short phrases** added to statements for confirmation.

For example;

- “You are coming to the party, aren't you?”
- “She loves reading, doesn't she?”

These tags enhance communication and clarify understanding.

01 Match the tag to the verb

Ensure that the question tag aligns with the main verb in the sentence for clarity and correctness.

---

02 Positive statements use Negative tags

When the statement is **POSITIVE**, remember to use a **NEGATIVE** question tag to create contrast and engage the listener.

---

03 Negative statements use Positive tags

Conversely, if the statement is **NEGATIVE**, the question tag should be **POSITIVE**, maintaining the balance in the conversation.

“Question tags make conversations **more engaging** and help confirm information in a friendly manner.”

Using the right tag can significantly improve clarity and foster better understanding in your **everyday discussions**.
